IV. TRANSCRIPTS

You will need to request a transcript of grades from your high school and other educational institutions attended. Transcripts are to be sent directly to Rosebud School of the Arts.

Call Alberta Education at 310-000 to request your high school transcript. Online requests do NOT work for Rosebud School of the Arts. Please allow the institution sufficient time to process and send you transcript directly to Rosebud School of the Arts. Many schools require a small fee for this service.

V. PERSONAL STATEMENT

Your Personal Statement helps us to get to know you in a way that's different form courses, grades and other objective data. It is your opportunity to organize your thoughts and express your dreams.

In the first few pages of the Academic Calendar you will read what Rosebud School of the Arts is all about. As you apply for admission, it is important that you communicate your understanding of what RSA offers and how you see yourself a part of it. We would like to hear how you see yourself growing, developing and contributing to RSA. You may write about your sense of purpose, direction, world view, artistic background, ability to work in a cooperative setting, faith journey and skills etc.

Please submit a Personal Statement written on a computer in a word document, and write approximately 350-400 words.

VI. LETTERS OF REFERENCE

Ask three people to fill out and mail in the reference form. The referees should be a variety of people who know you well at this point in your life, for example a teacher, employer or friend. Please do not ask family members to fill out a reference. Section I of the form is to be filled in by the applicant.

Your references should be chosen to fulfill two purposes:

- To provide evidence of previous accomplishments in the arts and other fields.
- To provide a character reference in terms of spiritual growth and work habits.

REFEREES SEND THE FORM DIRECTLY TO ROSEBUD SCHOOL OF THE ARTS, WHERE THEY REMAIN CONFIDENTIAL.

VII. PHOTOGRAPH

Please enclose a recent photograph of you. If you have a theatre headshot, you may submit it, but a photograph with a clear image of your face is sufficient.

VIII. APPLICATION FEE

The Application Fee of \$150.00 covers all administrative costs, as well as RSA Weekend expenses (including accommodation and meals). A cheque is preferable, but you may also pay by credit card or e-transfer. You may contact the Recruitment Officer to make credit card or e-transfer arrangements.

XI. RSA WEEKEND

After your application is sent to Rosebud School of the Arts, the next step in your application process is to attend an RSA Weekend and discover Rosebud for yourself. You will audit classes, see a show at Rosebud Theatre, work in hospitality, experience small town life, ask all your questions and reflect on the direction your life is meant to take. By the end of the weekend, you may sense if Rosebud is the right place for your growth as an artist. RSA weekends are offered throughout the year at times suitable for both the school and the applicant. Contact the RECRUITMENT OFFICER to book your RSA Weekend.

Schedule:

Applicants usually settle into accommodation on Thursday afternoon and leave Sunday morning. The weekend is filled with various activities designed to give applicants ample opportunity to discover Rosebud and meet the staff and students. Applicants are scheduled to observe classes – for example choir and acting – as they are offered, and they will attend a dinner and theatre performance. Applicants may be asked to assist with some of the daily tasks of a working dinner and theatre. An interview and talent assessment rounds out the week. The schedule will be given to the applicant upon arrival in Rosebud. If you require a ride from the Calgary airport to Rosebud, an extra \$35 is required along with your application fee.

Talent Assessment:

For the Talent Assessment, please prepare a one to three minute monologue and a song. Please do not perform a piece that you have written yourself. The song will be sung a cappella or you may accompany yourself: no musical accompaniment is provided.

AFTER THE RSA WEEKEND

You are informed of the Education Department's decision through a mailed letter from the Registrar.

Applications received after May 1st will be determined on programme availability. You may defer your acceptance one year.

* The application must be complete (including references and transcripts) before RSA can process an applicant's acceptance.

XIII. TUITION DEPOSIT

Once you are accepted into the programme, a non-refundable tuition deposit of \$250 is due June 30th to secure your enrollment. The deposit is made out to ROSEBUD SCHOOL OF THE ARTS and sent to Box 654, Rosebud AB, TOJ 2TO.

SPECIAL CASES

TRANSFER STUDENTS

RSA welcomes applications for Mentorship Level 1 and Level 2 from students who have taken training elsewhere equivalent to RSA's Theatre Foundations or Mentorship Level 1 Programme. As a conservatory-based training programme, RSA accepts transfer credit on a block basis only.

RSA has an exciting transfer partnership with Crandall University in Moncton, NB. Contact our Recruitment Officer for more details.

MATURE STUDENTS

Special admission may be granted to adult students without a high school diploma, if a student is at least 21 years of age, has appropriate work or volunteer experience and has been out of school for a minimum of two years. A General Equivalency Diploma (GED) is recommended.

HOME-SCHOOLED STUDENTS

RSA welcomes students from a home-schooling background. The applicant's readiness for RSA programmes can be demonstrated in one of two ways.

- 1. General Equivalency Diploma (GED) with a score of 450 or higher in Language Arts (Writing), Language Arts (Reading), and Social Studies.
- 2. A portfolio that meets RSA requirements. An explanation of RSA's portfolio requirements is available upon request.

PART TIME STUDENTS

Training in Rosebud requires a full-time commitment. Part-time study is not possible towards the completion of a particular programme. Registration for Open Studies may be considered if the applicant's abilities and circumstance warrant special consideration.

STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

RSA welcomes students with disabilities who meet current academic and programme admission standards. RSA makes its best effort to accommodate the needs of qualified students with disabilities. Students must note on their application any special needs or limitations and give an accurate account of their medical and/or psychological history, so that the Rosebud staff can make appropriate accommodation.

RSA students live in rental suites, not operated nor supervised by Rosebud School of the Arts. Students will be most successful in RSA programmes if they possess fundamental life skills necessary for independent living.

Experience has demonstrated that applicants who inform us of their needs up-front generally experience little trouble during the school year and are successful in their studies. Applicants who try to "down-play" their condition do not fare as well. Rosebud School of the Arts expects truthful communication from parents as well as students. You are assured that your needs will be treated with respect and confidentiality.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students are welcome at Rosebud School of the Arts in a short-term Open Studies Programme. RSA requires that students demonstrate an adequate level of speaking and writing in English. Students need to understand English sufficiently to participate in all aspects of classes, including lectures, reading, writing and discussion. English competency is assessed through the interview and written component of the application process.
