FEE POLICIES

Payment Method

Reception Desk: cash, cheque, MasterCard, Visa. Cheques made out to Rosebud School of the Arts.

Box Office: debit, MasterCard, Visa.

Receipts

Receipts are issued upon request for payment made. Tax receipts (T2202, T2202A) are issued in the student's name before the end of February for authorized tuition and fees assessed and paid during the previous tax year. No receipts are given for any funds which are still outstanding until these are paid in full.

TUITION PAYMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students pay tuition through an installment plan:

10% Tuition Deposit. Due date June 30, 2018

\$780 – Open Studies

25% First Installment. Due date September 4, 2018

\$1,950 – Open Studies

25% Second Installment. Due date December 22, 2018

\$1,950 – Open Studies

40% Final Installment. Due date April 26, 2019

\$3,120 – Open Studies

FEE PAYMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International student pay in full mandatory fees and pre-paid shows and textbooks on the first day of term:

Fall term due date September 4, 2018

\$1,200 – Open Studies

Winter term due date January 8, 2019

\$1,175 – Open Studies

OUTSTANDING ACCOUNTS

1. Students will be dismissed from the programme if tuition and fees are not paid by the deadline.
2. Official acknowledgment of programme completion is withheld until outstanding accounts with Rosebud School of the Arts are paid in full.
3. Transcripts and evaluations will not be released until outstanding accounts have been paid in full.

REFUND

1. Should Rosebud School of the Arts cease to exist, any tuition fees for the non-delivered portion of the course will be reimbursed in full.
2. Should a designated RSA programme (Theatre Foundations, Mentorship 1, 2, 3, Music Internship, Open Studies) cease to run, any tuition fees for the non-delivered portion of the course will be reimbursed in full.

3. In the event that a student is expelled or withdraws from the programme, there is no refund of tuition paid through the installment plan.
4. Tuition refund for an international student will be paid to the student, individual, or organization that originally paid the tuition.

Mandatory fees and study trip fees will not be refunded.
Credit on the Show and Textbook Account will be refunded.
